**Autumn 2 — Colours and
Celebrations.**

Communication and Language.

Nursery we will be singing familiar songs and learning some new ones.

Staff have set up a role play area of a car and shop to promote speaking and listening. In phonics we are listening to sounds outside and to instruments inside. We are doing lots of rhyming activities to identify words that sound the same.

Literacy

In Literacy children will have stories and rhymes told to them and will be asked questions about the main character and the setting of the story. Children will begin to self register, finding their name card when they enter Nursery and post it in a postbox. We are also going to start an 'I can read book' with shop and brand logos such as, ASDA, Nike tick and McDonalds, which is early reading and a confident booster to help children feel they can read.

Physical Development.

We are continuing our work started last half term to help children's fine motor control which is the foundations for letter writing. Staff will be providing many opportunities for squeezing, patting, pushing and pulling etc. using fingers and thumbs.

Maths

Children will be counting every day objects such as children in Nursery on a daily basis and recognising written numerals. We are going to be doing lots of one to one counting of objects. If number 5 is shown, children count out 5 objects and realise when to stop.



Understanding of the World.

We are going to be celebrating the many different celebrations. Bonfire night and firework safety. Children in Need and supporting other children less fortunate to us. Christmas and the Christmas story.

Creative development.

In Nursery we will continue to exploring colours through painting, cutting and sticking etc. We will be doing lots of singing, playing of instruments and trying to play to a steady beat.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

This half term we are promoting kind behaviour towards others and the Nursery environment. We will also be encouraging children to help friends who need help with tasks such as putting on coats and opening straw packets.

How you can help!

Encourage the children to share what they have learnt each day.

Read at least 3 times a week with your child, including your child's reading book.

Practice counting objects at home and stopping when they say the target number.

Create an 'I can read' scrapbook at home. Look in magazines and newspapers. When your child identifies a picture or symbol place it in your own scrapbook.
