Nursery

Autumn 1 — Here I am (Ourselves).

Communication and Language.

Nursery we will be singing familiar songs and learning some new ones. Staff have set up a role play area which will encourage speaking and listening skills. Children will have opportunities to speak and listen to each other about what activities they chose to do in their independent learning time and at home.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

This half term we will be focussing on inducting children into school nursery. Staff will be interacting with children, getting to know them and enabling the children to get to know the staff. We will also be encouraging children to share and turn take through sessions and giving children lots of praise for doing the right thing.



Physical Development.

Various activities will be placed outside in the garden for them to improve their physical skills. Children will be encouraged to become more aware of others and objects while there are moving.



Maths

Children will be counting every day objects such as children in Nursery on a daily basis and recognising written numerals. Staff will also speak about the day of the week and the sequence of what children will be doing at the start of sessions.

Literacy

In Literacy children will have stories and rhymes told to them and will be asked questions about the main character and the setting of the story. We will be helping children to write their name and read it when they arrive at Nursery.

Understanding of the World.

Children will be learning about Nursery, the rules, Routines, staff and each other. While in Nursery children will have access to explore the different areas of the environment such as book and creative areas.

Creative development.

In Nursery we will be exploring colours through painting, cutting and sticking and play dough and explore different ways of using these resources.
