Christmas Concert

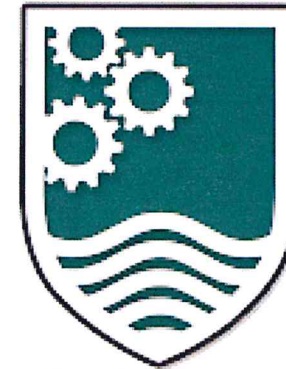
This half-term Year 2 & 3 will be performing a selection of songs to host a Christmas concert.

P.E

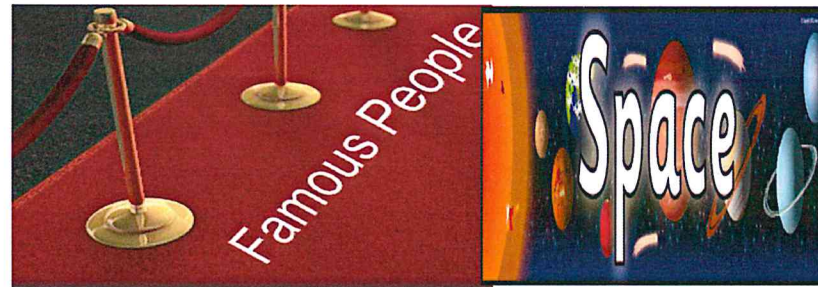
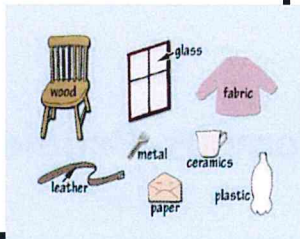
This will be on a Wednesday for both classes and is taught by a specialised PE coach.
