Numeracy

During this half term we will cover:

Literacy



Fiction and Non-fiction: We will be looking at the role of jobs of famous people. We will be writing character descriptions, describing the different types of settings and non-chronological reports. We will also be writing recounts of events.

SPaG:

We will be learning how to form sentences, with capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Children will learn how to expand sentences using connectives and adjectives.

Spelling: We will focus on the spelling pattern g, ge and dge,

Forces

We will look Forces and what forces are present around us. The children will engage in different experiments on forces. They will learn about forces affect the distance a car travels and how it can alter the shape of items.
