How can you help at home?

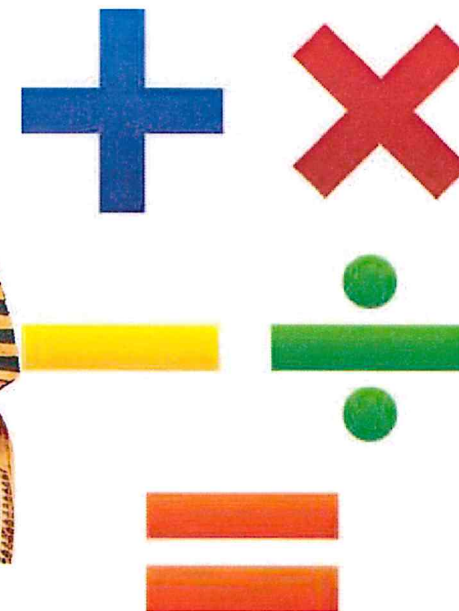
- Listen to your child read and ask them questions about what they have read.

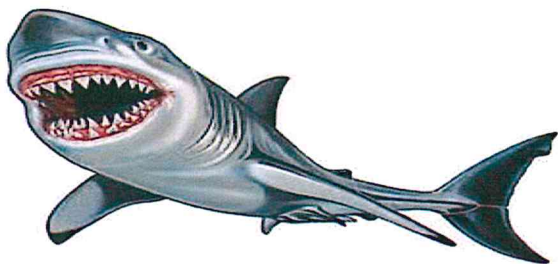
Literacy

This half term we will be writing and performing raps and poems. After this we will investigate the death of Tutankhamun and use our findings to produce a range of non-fiction writing.

We will continue to encourage the children to write at length throughout the week. Children will also take part in guided reading and daily spelling and grammar activities.

Maths

This half term, the children will continue to learn about more complex addition and subtraction. They will also be completing work involving multiplication (three, four and eight times tables). After this they will learn to divide objects and numbers by two and by four. The children will be taught to apply their maths knowledge to real life situations and complete problem solving activities.



Curriculum

Initially the children will be completing their work on Ancient Greece. They will be moulding a pot out of clay and designing a Greek plate.

For the remaining two weeks, the children have chosen to learn about animals including those that live in the sea. We will be completing a range of creative activities including still life drawings, mosaics and multimedia collages. In addition to this, we will be investigating different seas and oceans around the world.
