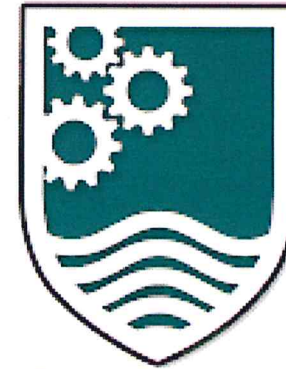
P.E day: Both classes have P.E. on Thursday afternoons.

## Numeracy

This half-term children will be reading and writing numbers to 100,000 and 1, 000, 000. They will go onto compare numbers to 1,000,000. Then they will go onto identifying and making number patterns. As well as rounding numbers five and six digit numbers to the nearest 100, 1000 and 10, 000.

## Literacy

In this unit, the children explore the mission: to run the Museum of Fun! They read the interactive eBook, scanning and summarising information and relating it to their lives and experiences. They complete the mission, planning, writing and presenting television adverts to encourage people to visit the museum. The children will discuss all the poems in the unit, giving their own reasons for preferences. They will draft whole-class poems, evaluating and editing as they go. Further composition work includes drafting and writing a nonsense-writing poem and a free-verse poem. They also prepare poems to read aloud.

## ICT

This half term the children will learn to carry out tasks with instructions. To be able to put a set of instructions together to create a command that controls an icon. They will also be able to identify bugs in the programme and correct them. As well as producing a series of commands.

## Science

At the beginning of the year children will be learning about and testing different materials to see which ones are suitable for a range of different purposes.
