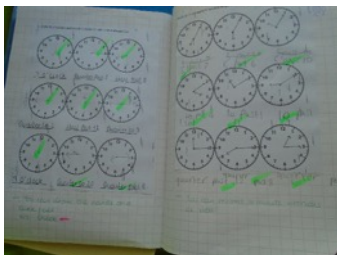
Spotlight on... Year 2



This term in Year 2 the Topic is "Wriggle and Crawl". The children have been learning about different mini-beasts and particularly learning about how honey is made. During our science lesson the children were allowed to taste honey!



In English the children have written their own non-chronological report about snails. They have enjoyed reading lots of facts on their favourite mini-beast. In Art and D&T they have made a 3D bee, a 3D caterpillar and a 3D butterfly. From this the children wrote lots of instructions on how to make them.



In Maths this term the children have learnt to read and record 15 minute intervals on an analogue clock. The children have recorded the times and learnt to draw the hands on a clock face to match the correct time.
