**Visit to Grand Central, Birmingham.
Tuesday 21st April 2020**

The Geography Department are delighted to give your child the opportunity for a human fieldtrip to Grand Central, Birmingham.

The visit will give your son/daughter visual learning linking to their GCSE grade, however it is also a **compulsory element of the examination specification**. Pupils will be asked questions about this visit during their June 2020 Geography examination, which will be worth 25% of their final Geography GCSE. The visit will include studying urban generation and how it affects the local economy of Birmingham.

As pupils are required to study how regeneration links to tourism and transport, we will be travelling to Birmingham by train. Pupils will leave the academy at 11.00am and walk to the station accompanied by staff. Timings below are approximate, final timings will be confirmed.

Train tickets will be booked and paid for in advance by the academy. Pupils will not be required to return to school from Bloxwich Train Station. We therefore ask that you arrange for your child to return home.
