Dear Parent/Carer,

Further to the announcement that schools may be able to start welcoming back Nursery, Reception, Year 1 & Year 6 children from the 1<sup>st</sup> June, we want to reassure parents that we have started to carefully plan for the potential return for these pupils.

These plans will incorporate strict guidelines surrounding social distancing and hygiene, and every consideration will be made before we resume learning on site. We will keep parents informed as our plans develop through the school website and Twitter.
