

Phased Re-Opening For the Primary School

Dear Parents & Carers,

I hope that everyone is well and thank you for your continued support in engaging with the online learning. As you will be aware, there has been updated guidance from the Government which we have used to enable you to make an informed decision about whether or not to send your child back into school.

As long as the government continues to say it is safe, we will begin a staggered return for some pupils from Monday 8th June 2020 starting with Year 1 and Year 6 pupils as well as continuing provision for identified children including those of key workers.

Pupils will receive a specific time to attend school each day. When they are on site, they will be placed into teaching groups of a maximum of 14 pupils allowing for sufficient spacing between pupils in classrooms.

When pupils are on site, they will remain in the same room for the duration of their lessons. Pupils will not necessarily be placed with the same teacher they had before the enforced closure. We will contact you again, after half-term, detailing the specific arrangements for your child's return to school.

In the meantime, we are following government advice to ensure the school site will be safe for all staff and children to return. The safety and welfare of our pupils, staff and their wider families is our number one priority.

Please keep using the online work and do not hesitate to contact us if you are experiencing any difficulties accessing it.

Stay safe and we look forward to welcoming you back to school very soon.
