Subject	Tasks

Maths	Mymaths tasks - Percentages revision or Probability (9B3) Home learning worksheets (year 9 week 9 folder)
Science	Year 9: Week 5 Folder - Particle Model and Working Scientifically. Open the power point, read the instructions and complete the tasks set
History	Enquiry 3: Who healed the sick in the Middle-Ages? (Part 2) Booklet pages 10-14 Read the information on Terrifying treatments and Herbal remedies Complete activities 1, 2a-b, 3a-b and 4a-b (highlighted in yellow)
Geography	Complete hour 2 of the rivers booklet. Note- this is a three-week task so please do not continue to the next hours Due: Friday 22nd May. Please email any work onto your teacher (S Thomson or S Marrison). Stretch activity: Research how different countries around the world have responded to Coronavirus. Drama	Year 9 Home Learning Drama Work presentation on the shared area. Complete slides 18, 19,20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26 on A Doll's House.
