Dear Parent/Carer

We hope you are all keeping well and are looking forward to your child returning to school; we are really looking forward to welcoming them back. We understand that this may be an anxious time, therefore we wanted to share with you the plans we have put in place following the Government's decision to re-open schools. We have worked hard to ensure that your child will be as safe as possible and hope these measures will ensure a happy and successful return to school.

School will be open for Year 12 students from Monday 15th June. Student and staff safety is paramount and therefore the following processes have been implemented:

- Students to arrive on site at 9.15am and enter the school grounds through the double gate entry located on Willenhall Lane (at the rear of the building).
- Students are to stop at the safety check point and await directions from staff. They will need to queue in accordance with social distancing guidelines (2 metre distance between you and anyone else) up to this point.
- Students will then be directed into a hygiene tent where their temperature will be checked using a non-contact thermometer and they will wash their hands.
- Students will then make their way across the back playground and enter the Tower Block through the ground floor door, where there will be a one-way system in place for entry and exit. The one way system in and out of the Tower Block must be followed at all times. The exception to this will be any Art or Textiles students who will spend all of their lesson time in the Art or Textiles classroom.
- Students are not required to wear uniform and are expected to wear a clean set of clothes each day.
- Students may wear a mask and bring in their own hand sanitiser; however, tissues and sanitiser will be available in school.
- Students will need to bring a drink into school with them, as communal water machines will not be available for use during their time in school.
- Each teaching session will last for three hours, where students will remain in the same classroom for the duration of the session. There will be a 10 minute comfort break, which will be staggered for each group on each day.
- Students will be dismissed between 12.15pm and 12.30pm and are required to leave the school site immediately. Students will apply hand sanitiser before leaving their class. May we remind parents that students should change clothes as soon as they return home.
