I am sure by now you are aware that we all find ourselves in a national lockdown due to the rising Covid-19 infections. Bloxwich Academy Primary, including Nursery, will be closed until **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021**.

During this time, the Academy will provide provision for all children of key workers or those classed as vulnerable. Pupils who have an Education Healthcare Plan and are deemed vulnerable will be contacted individually to assess their requirements.

Over the past few weeks, we have monitored the situation closely and have been making preparations for such circumstances. **From tomorrow (6<sup>th</sup> January 2021)** online learning will begin and can be accessed via Microsoft Teams using the below webpage:
