## Dear Parent/Carer

I hope you and your family have enjoyed the summer break and you are all looking forward to the start of the autumn term.

The Government instructions to all schools regarding lateral flow testing has not changed since my last letter to you all in July and therefore it is important I share with you again the planned schedule for pupils to return in September.

We need to conduct two lateral flow tests and therefore require a staggered return for pupils.

## **Friday 3rd September**

**Year 11 and 6th Form** - Arrive at 12 noon (12pm) – Leamore Lane entrance for testing only. Pupils depart once the test is completed. Please note pupils **DO NOT** need to wear uniform when they come in for testing.

Year 11 Prefects are required all day to support Year 7, therefore they will need to be in school by 8.00am to allow time for their lateral flow tests to be undertaken. Prefects will be required to wear full uniform.

## **Monday 6th September**

Year 11 - Arrive 8.45am - Leamore Lane entrance - normal school day - depart 3.00pm. All Year 11 pupils to have full uniform and equipment.

Year 10 – Arrive 9.00am – Leamore Lane entrance and assemble in the canteen – normal lessons will resume once testing is completed – depart 3.00pm. All Year 10 pupils to have full uniform and equipment.

**Year 9** – Arrive 11.30am – Willenhall Lane entrance and assemble in the canteen. Pupils will depart once testing is completed. Year 9 pupils will not be required to wear uniform for testing.

Year 8 – Arrive 1.30pm – Leamore Lane entrance and assemble in the canteen. Pupils will depart once testing is completed. Year 8 pupils will not be required to wear uniform for testing.
