As last year, we will be creating new, smaller class groups for September. Since introducing this system in September 2021 we have seen a positive impact on the learning experience of children, and continue to see this as an opportunity for children to get to know fellow pupils in their year group better, developing their social and emotional understanding. Registration groups are still being created. Once this is finalised, we will send details out to parents/carers.

I would like to take this opportunity to also remind parents of the uniform policy here at Bloxwich Academy Primary. Children are required to wear plain black trousers or skirt, with a white polo neck t-shirt and black shoes. A black cardigan or jumper is also permitted in cold weather. The PE kit is also white and black with plain black pumps (no branding). We strongly recommend that parents write their child's name inside all items of school uniform so that we can reunite any articles with their owner. From September, any lost uniform that does not have a child's name written on the label will be placed in one of three large containers which will be located outside the school office. There will be a different container for each Key Stage and these containers will be emptied every half term with anything not claimed donated to charity.
