

Religious Education Framework Overview (2023/24)

Overview

This progression map shows the concepts and small steps taught to pupils from Year 1 to Year 6. Religious Education is mapped across each term and concepts revisited incorporating a spiral approach through retrieval this is to ensure we broaden and deepen pupils' knowledge and they have the chance to use and apply new knowledge. In brackets, after the concept, is the small steps taught for remembering and mastering.
