

Curriculum Intent: Developing resilience, expression and communication through performing, appraising and composing.

Curriculum Rationale: Pupils will explore a variety of different musical genres, techniques and instruments through performing, appraising and composing. They will experience and investigate the historical and cultural impact of music in society and develop resilience, expression, and effective communication by working as an individual and as part of an ensemble. Pupils will develop transferable skills through their music education and more significantly a lifelong appreciation of music in their everyday lives.
