Curriculum Intent: Within the textiles department we strive to push innovative designers to understand and use the knowledge and expertise to create garments which encompasses all backgrounds and styles.

Curriculum Rationale: Textile design can be defined as the creation of designs and products for woven, knitted, stitched or printed fabrics. At Bloxwich Academy we encompass all areas of this creativity by allowing our students to experiment with a variety of different techniques and mixed media. By the end of the rotation the students will be able to use their knowledge and skills to create and decorate a product by using a range of textile techniques. Students will also understand different cultures and fashion that exists around the world.

What makes the Bloxwich experience unique: Unlike many schools we do not expect pupils and parents to provide the tools or Fabrics pupils need for their lessons. We believe that all pupils should learn the vital life skill of Textiles and so no pupil will be disadvantaged because of the cost of materials. Therefore, we use our funding to buy all materials throughout KS3 & KS4 so that everyone has full access to our curriculum.
