Pupils are aware of our examination routines, which remain unchanged from their last mock series.

As part of the formalities of the exam season, we are required to remind you and your child that pupils sitting examinations are bound by the regulations set out by JCQ. We, as a school will continue to remind pupils at regular intervals of these rules and will continue to make clear the expectations. However, please do take the time to discuss with your child the importance of these rules as a failure to follow them will result in a referral to the awarding bodies who will sanction in line with their policies.
