Our inclusive, multi-sensory handwriting curriculum is tailored to support each child's unique needs, promoting fine motor skills and letter formation. This approach enhances their ability to express ideas across all subjects.

To reinforce these skills at home, we recommend engaging in activities that strengthen fine motor abilities, such as playing with playdough, threading beads, or using tweezers to pick up small objects. Additionally, practicing letter shapes in tactile mediums like sand or salt trays can be beneficial.
