We are delighted to inform you that Year 1 will be having a special WOW Day on Wednesday 7th January 2026 to launch our new topic, Bright Lights, Big City.

The day will be full of exciting activities to help bring our learning to life. During the Spring term, the children will learn about a local landmark and explore the countries that make up the United Kingdom, including their locations, capital cities, and some physical and human features. They will take part in simple map work, using compasses and positional and directional language to plan routes around London.
