### End of Spring Term

As we end the spring term, I am writing to share some reminders.

Term will end for pupils on Friday 27th March 2026. School will reopen to pupils on Monday 13th April 2026. The two-week break will be a welcome rest for many, particularly the Year 11 pupils who are on the final countdown for their exams which begin on Tuesday 5th May.

This term has been a particularly exciting and enriching one for our pupils. We have seen a wide range of opportunities that have supported both academic progress and personal development. Highlights have included visits from universities as part of the Oxbridge Schools Tour, helping to raise aspirations and provide insight into future pathways. Pupils have also taken part in a Trust-wide community art project, celebrating creativity, teamwork and a shared sense of belonging across our schools. In addition, events such as careers activities, Cross-trust trips to Paris and Germany, reading rewards, enrichment clubs, and visiting speakers have all contributed to a vibrant and engaging term for our pupils.

When pupils return on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April they are expected to wear full school uniform and to have the correct equipment including their school planner. A reminder of the uniform policy can be found here: [Uniform Reminder - Bloxwich Academy](#).

Reminder that no child under 16 will be given prescription or non-prescription medicines without their parent's written consent. The school will only accept prescribed medicines that are in-date, labelled, provided in the original container as dispensed by a pharmacist and include instructions for administration, dosage and storage. Parents/Carers should provide written consent by completing and signing a form which is available on Main Reception. All medicines will be stored safely, and pupils will be informed of the location of these, so they are able to access them when needed. Medication will be taken under the supervision of an adult. Pupils should not be given medications at home to bring with them on to school site. This is to ensure their safety and that of others.

As we move into the holiday period, we ask for your support in ensuring that all pupils remain safe and make positive choices. This includes staying safe in the community, being mindful of road safety, and using social media responsibly. We encourage families to have regular conversations about online safety, appropriate behaviour, and knowing how to seek help if needed.

We would also like to remind pupils of the importance of continuing to demonstrate the values of our school during the break. Whether at home, out with friends, or online, showing respect, responsibility, and kindness helps our young people represent themselves positively.

A reminder that our Breakfast Club is available every school day and will continue when we return after the holidays. The school opens from 8:00am, giving pupils the opportunity to enjoy breakfast before the start of the school day. A range of breakfast items are available, with each item priced at 80p. Pupils who receive Free School Meals can use their 80p allowance at Breakfast Club or during break time as usual. Breakfast Club is a valuable opportunity for pupils to begin the day with a healthy
