Dear Parent/Carer,

As we enter the GCSE examination season, we would like to share key information about the arrangements in place to support our Year 11 pupils.

Breakfast Club and Morning Arrangements

As part of our existing Breakfast Club provision, Year 11 pupils are encouraged to attend from 8:00am on examination days. Pupils can access breakfast in the canteen before moving to the gym, which will be a quiet revision space for Year 11 only. Staff will be present to supervise and offer last-minute support.

Arrival for Examinations

Pupils must be on site in the gym by 8:40am on the day of an examination. Pupils who arrive late may not be permitted to enter the exam venue, which could significantly affect their outcomes.

After Afternoon Examinations

Pupils may leave site once they have completed their afternoon examinations. Any pupil wishing to remain on site must go directly to the Annex, where they will be supervised until Period 6.

Period 6 and Booster Sessions

From 11th May, the normal Period 6 timetable will be suspended. Period 6 will instead provide targeted support for subjects with examinations the following day. Additionally, "day before" Maths and English booster sessions will take place during Period 5 before an exam. Pupils will be informed of further details.

Examination Conduct

Pupils are reminded that JCQ regulations must be followed at all times. These can be found in the Pupil Life – Exams section of the Bloxwich Academy website, and on the JCQ website.

Please continue to encourage your child to use available online revision platforms, including Sparx Maths and KayScience. Please also encourage them to utilise the resources provided to ensure they are as prepared as possible for their examinations.
