At Bloxwich Academy Primary, we are committed to listening to our parents and carers. Below is a summary of how your feedback has shaped our actions, grouped under key discussion areas from the March 2026 Parent Advisory Forum meeting..

Focus	Parents Said	We Did
Curriculum and Academic Support	• Parents would like greater clarity around phonics reading book levels and academic expectations. • Some parents felt pupil reports could identify areas for development more clearly. • More support is needed to encourage reading at home. • Parents were unaware of some reading rewards, including Starbooks Reading Café. • Suggestions included reminders about Boom Reader logins, book reviews, and improved promotion of reading initiatives. • Parents requested workshops on behaviour, sleep and mathematics. • Accessibility can be difficult for parents with younger children attending events.	• Academic expectations, including Phonics, Multiplication Tables Check, SATs and EYFS Good Level of Development, were clarified and discussed with parents. • Parents were reminded that report QR codes provide a direct route for further discussion with teachers. • Reading remains a key school priority, with continued promotion of Boom Reader and home reading expectations. • A book vending machine has been introduced, with rewards linked to reading engagement. • The school agreed to produce clearer information about reading rewards, including Starbooks Reading Café, and explore additional promotional materials. • Workshops focusing on behaviour, sleep and curriculum support are being explored, including opportunities for online sessions via Teams. • Suggestions to improve accessibility for parents, including potential childcare support during events, are being considered.
